Why Pilgrimage to Rome?



With a population of 2.7 million, Rome is one of the most populated cities in Europe and one of the very oldest, dating to 753 B.C — almost 2,800 years ago. As we stroll over the time-worn cobblestones, the many layers of Roman history will begin to unfold. From the sculpture and architecture of the Ancients to the vestiges left from the early Church, through the Medieval and Renaissance periods with the masterpieces of artists such as Michelangelo, Raphael and Bernini, Rome is truly a treasure trove of culture, history and faith.

Within the heart of the city of Rome is the sovereign city-state, Vatican City, whose territory consists of a walled enclave. The Vatican is the smallest sovereign state in the world and has an area of approximately 110 acres and a population of around 840.

This is a unique time in the Vatican, as Pope Francis continues to define his pontificate and Emeritus Pope Benedict continues to reside in Vatican City in a small convent inside the Vatican Gardens not far from the *Domus Santa Marta*, the residence of Pope Francis. The Vatican will be quiet in the early fall, and we will have the opportunity to roam the streets in peace. The oppressive heat of the summer months will have departed, and though it can get quite cool at night, the days will likely be warm enough to enjoy a coffee or a meal al fresco.

It is a privileged time to be part of the living Body of Christ, among the “living stones” of the Church, during these days of the “two Popes” — Benedict and Francis — so very different and yet each so filled with the love of Christ and His Church.

DAYS 7, 8 AND 9: ROME

- Attend a Papal Audience as a guest of *Inside the Vatican* magazine
- Enjoy a walking tour of Baroque Rome led by Dr. Moynihan to the Spanish Steps, Trevi Fountain, Pantheon and Piazza Navona, including viewing five Caravaggio paintings and the Madonna Del Popolo, the miraculous image of Our Lady painted by St. Luke
- Visit the Basilica of Sant'Andrea delle Fratte, where Our Lady appeared to Alphonse Ratisbonne in the same image as she appears on the Miraculous Medal and where St. Maximilian Kolbe offered his first Mass
- Enjoy a guided tour of the Sistine Chapel, St. Peter's Basilica and the Vatican Museum
- Climb the Holy Stairs near the Basilica of St. John Lateran
- Visit Santa Croce, the church containing relics of the Passion from Jerusalem (time permitting)

Villa Serenella



VILLA SERENELLA IS A STATELY, TYPICALLY ROMAN VILLA-TURNED-MONASTERY SURROUNDED BY 13 ACRES OF OLIVE GROVES, PINE TREES, WALKING PATHS, A SOCCER FIELD AND FOUNTAINS.



Just three miles from the Vatican, the Villa is owned by the Antonine order of Lebanese Maronite Catholic monks. Yes, you will be staying with monks from Lebanon! The monks chant their prayers in the morning and evening, and then, sometimes, join with young pilgrims in friendly soccer games!


Set apart from the surrounding area of Rome, Villa Serenella is situated on top of a hill. The grounds allow for pilgrims to be outside after a long day of touring the city — to relax and regroup among the olive trees, the Italian pines and fountains! Evenings may even include a cookout on the villa's outdoor piazza, a chance to enjoy the lovely scenery and chat with fellow pilgrims about the day's events.

At the Villa Serenella, you will have complete and private use of the entire guest house which was built in 2016 and contains modern lighting, showers and air conditioning. And the Villa is not only a comfortable and spacious setting; it is also a secure and safe environment — it has a walled perimeter and locked iron gates at each entrance, to which each pilgrim receives two keys (one is an entry key).

ITALY: ROME IN THE FALL | SEPTEMBER 24 – OCTOBER 2, 2020

The Eternal City and the Domain of the Popes

In this pilgrimage journey, we'll encounter the living stones in the Church today. We have scheduled plenty of free time to allow pilgrims to rest or explore Rome at their leisure. Each day we will have the opportunity to attend Mass. As a note, we prefer to schedule Mass in the morning, but there is a possibility that Mass times can fluctuate due to circumstances and Vatican events. The Mass schedule will be finalized as we approach the departure date.

ARRIVAL – THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 2020

Welcome to Italy! You arrive at Fiumicino airport, about 10 miles outside of Rome to the west, near the Mediterranean Sea. You may have seen the sea as your plane circled to land. You will be met at the airport immediately as you exit the secured area. Depending on your arrival time, there may be time for your first *café* and *cornetto*. Your group transfer will take you to the majestic Villa Serenella, a stately, typically Roman villa-turned-monastery and our Roman home for the next eight nights.

After we settle into the Villa, there will be time for lunch and rest before we depart for the Vatican and St. Peter's Square. There, you will be introduced to Dr. Robert Moynihan and Deborah Tomlinson. Dr. Moynihan, one of the world's leading Vatican analysts and founder and editor of *Inside the Vatican* magazine, will lead us on a "familiarization" walk to St. Peter's Square in front of St. Peter's Basilica.

After our walk, we will stroll only two short blocks to the Basilica of Santo Spirito, the shrine of the Divine Mercy in Rome for our "welcome" Mass and confessions.

In the evening, we will return to the monastery for a Welcome Dinner with Dr. Moynihan. Our first day will end early so we can all be rested for the journey to come.

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 25

Rome

After breakfast at the monastery, we will depart to visit two of the four papal basilicas in Rome: **St. Mary Major** and **St. John Lateran** — both glorious monuments to the Faith, containing treasures of art and faith that can take one's breath away.

In St. Mary Major, for example, there is a painting of Mary called the **Salus Populi Romani**, believed to have been painted by St. Luke himself. St. John Lateran is the oldest and ranks first among the four Papal basilicas of Rome, since it is the cathedra or "seat" of the Pope. We will also visit the Holy Stairs, the steps of Pilate's Palace that Jesus ascended, and, time permitting, the Basilica of **Santa Croce in Gerusalemme**, which contains relics of Jesus' Passion, both located nearby.

Along with these visits, we will take a driving tour to see the wonders of ancient Rome, including the Roman Forum, the Coliseum, Palatine Hill, Circus Maximus and the Arch of Titus.

We will stop for lunch along the way on your own, and perhaps free time to shop and explore, before returning to the monastery for dinner. Overnight in Rome. 🍷 🏠

EUCCHARISTIC MIRACLE OF LANCIANO

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 26

Lanciano and Manoppello

Today we will travel to two shrines that house some of the most important miracles in Italy – the Eucharistic Miracle of Lanciano and the Shrine of the Holy Face in Manoppello.

We will be up early to travel about 2½ hours across Italy to the Adriatic Sea, to the town of Lanciano in the rugged Abruzzo region. In Lanciano, we will enter the church that houses the Eucharistic Miracle to behold the wonders of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ made visible.

We will stop at a local café in Lanciano for lunch on your own.

We will then turn back towards Rome, heading to the tiny town of Manoppello, Italy (population 157), still in the Abruzzo region, about 40 minutes away. There, we will visit the Shrine of the Holy Face, which houses a mysterious cloth bearing the image of a man with wounds on his face — an image some believe is the actual face of Christ formed at the moment of his Resurrection — and attend Mass.

Following our visit, we will return to the monastery for dinner and another night's rest. Overnight in Rome. 🍷 🏠

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 27

Rome

We will have breakfast at the Villa Serenella before departing for Sunday Mass in St. Peter's Basilica. After Mass we will gather in St. Peter's Square to hear Pope Francis's Angelus message and to pray with pilgrims from around the world.

In the afternoon, after lunch on your own near the Vatican, there will be free time to explore and shop for religious articles for the papal blessing on Wednesday before returning to the monastery for dinner. Overnight in Rome. 🍷🏠



APPIAN WAY

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 28

Rome

After breakfast in the Villa Serenella, we will make our way south of Rome to journey along the Appian Way, first constructed in 312 B.C., and visit the Papal Basilica of St. Paul's Outside-the-Walls, dedicated to the Apostle to the Gentiles and holding his tomb.

We will also explore the underground Catacombs of Callixtus, and then stop for lunch along the way, returning to the monastery for dinner in the evening. Overnight in Rome. 🍷🏠

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 29

Assisi and Rome

After an early breakfast we will travel to Assisi, home of St. Francis and St. Clare. Along our way we will stop at an Auto-grill, a real Italian experience, where you can purchase a *café* or light meal.

Pre-eminent among our many significant destinations are the Basilicas of St. Francis and St. Clare. Lunch will be in one of our favorite restaurants near the Piazza del Comune, one of the most beautiful piazzas in Italy.

After lunch, we will journey to the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels, in the valley below Assisi, which contains the Portiuncula, the ancient church St. Francis rebuilt after being called by Christ crucified to "rebuild His Church."

We will attend Mass in the basilica before we return to Rome. We will stop at an Auto-grill for dinner on your own. Overnight in Rome. 🍷🏠


WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 30

Rome

After breakfast in the monastery, we will depart again for Vatican City and the Papal Audience. Afterwards we will have lunch on your own near the Vatican, followed by free time.

Later, Dr. Moynihan will guide our walking tour of Baroque Rome, from the Spanish Steps to the Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon and the Piazza Navona. Along the way, Dr. Moynihan will peel back the layers of Roman and Church history for us. Our walk will begin at the Church of **Santa Maria del Popolo** to view two famous Caravaggio paintings and a miraculous image of Our Lady painted by St. Luke, then takes us by the Pantheon to San Luigi dei Franceschi to view three more paintings by Caravaggio depicting three moments in the life of Saint Matthew.

We will also visit the Basilica of Sant'Andrea delle Fratte, which has a very special side chapel where Our Lady appeared to Alphonse Ratisbonne, an avowed anti-Catholic Jew, in 1842, manifesting herself exactly as she appears on the Miraculous Medal, effecting his miraculous conversion. As we head back to the Vatican area, we will stop at another one of our favorite restaurants in Rome for dinner and enjoy a gelato from one of the best gelaterias in Rome before returning to the monastery. Overnight in Rome. 🍷🏠



Terms & Conditions

Inside the Vatican Pilgrimages, Inside the Vatican, Inc., its employees, shareholders, officers and directors are collectively referred to herein as "ITVP."

Household: ITVP defines household as those participants who dwell under the same roof and have the same address for at least 6 months per year.

Rates and Payments: Rates are based on applicable rates as of Oct 2019 and could change due to fluctuation in currency exchange rates or failure to have a minimum number of 15 passengers. If they change, we will invoice participants accordingly.

Land Package: \$2,699.00 per participant. Does not include airfare.

1st Payment: \$500.00 non-refundable deposit – Due at time of booking.

2nd Payment: Balance due July 24, 2020, 60 days from departure.

Single Supplement fee: \$700.00 for single occupancy room, if applicable. Due with 2nd payment.

Early Booking Discount: \$200.00 discount – register by April 1, 2020.

Cash Discount: \$100.00 Total amount of \$2,599.00 per participant for payment in full made by cash or check.

Installment payment plans: if each payment is made by cash or check, the cash discount of \$100.00 will be applied to final installment.

Reservations and Payment Schedule: A \$500.00 per participant, non-refundable deposit is due at the time of booking. Balance is due 60 days prior to departure. If your reservation is received less than 60 days prior to departure, then full payment is due at the time of booking. Receipt of your non-refundable deposit shall act as your agreement to and understanding of these terms and conditions. Fax, internet, e-mail or phone reservations are welcome. The non-refundable deposit and/or payment in full must be received within 7 days of booking or reservation will cancel. A contract is made when your reservation and payment are accepted by ITVP and any dispute shall be governed by Virginia law.

Form of Payment: Bank/Certified Checks, Money Orders, ACH or Wire Transfers (please fax a copy of bank confirmation when wiring funds) are accepted forms of payment at any time. Personal checks are acceptable if received more than 30 days prior to departure date. You may also make Direct Credit Card Payments to ITVP (Discover, Visa and Master Card). Every reservation must be accompanied by a signed Registration Form.

Returned checks will incur a \$50.00 service fee. In case of computer or human billing error, we reserve the right to re-invoice participants with corrected billing.

Transfers: Two (2) group transfers to and from Rome's Fiumicino airport (FCO) are included. Only participants whose flights arrive into FCO before noon on Thursday, September 24, 2020 and depart FCO no earlier than 10:00 a.m. on Friday, October 2, 2020 will be included in the group transfers. It is the responsibility of participant to notify ITVP of any flight delays. If the participant's flight is delayed and this delay causes the participant to miss the scheduled group transfer, the cost and arrangement of transfer from the airport to the hotel or location of the tour bus becomes the participant's responsibility. Individual transfers to and from the airport are not included in this package. Although ITVP can book an individual transfer to the airport upon request, the participant is financially responsible for that transfer.

Flight Schedule: Land Package participants are responsible for purchasing their own tickets to arrive into Rome airport (FCO) on Thursday, September 24, 2020 before 12:00 noon, and depart Rome airport (FCO) on Friday, October 2, 2020 after 10:00 a.m. Should a participant encounter a flight delay/cancellation, it is the participant's responsibility to notify ITVP.

Insurance: Travel insurance is not included in the Land Package; however, we strongly recommend that you consider purchasing it.

Travel Documents: All travel documents are the responsibility of the participant. A valid passport is required for travel to Italy and must remain valid for at least 6 months after your departure date from Italy. For passport holders from countries other than the United States, you are responsible for determining the required travel documents. ITVP will not be responsible for any delays, damages and/or losses, including missed portions of the pilgrimage, due to improper travel documentation. Cancellations due to lack of appropriate documents will incur the usual penalties.

U.S. State Department & Other Agencies: From time to time the U.S. State Department (www.state.gov) and the Center for Disease Control (www.cdc.gov) and other government agencies and departments issue travel advisories or warnings for one or more of the destinations that you may be visiting on tour. We encourage you to contact these agencies directly to obtain the most current information. ITVP cannot change the cancellation terms or conditions based on the issuance of any such warning or advisory or the occurrence of any terror, problems or ill health, or other incident in one or more of the places this tour is scheduled to visit. All cancellation penalties must remain in full force and effect as outlined on this form. Travel insurance may or may not cover these possible causes for cancellations.

Photography: Agents of ITVP may take photographs or videos of its trips and trip participants. Participants grant ITVP permission to do so and allow ITVP to use such photos and videos for promotional or commercial use without payment of any fees or royalties. These photos will be available on our photo website InsideTheVaticanPhotos.com following the pilgrimage. A code is required to download these photos from Inside the Vatican's photo gallery. The code will be provided after the pilgrimage.

Private Rooms and Single Supplement: A limited number of single rooms is available at the single supplement rate. If the allotted number of single rooms is booked, any additional single rooms that we may be able to book, if available, incur a fee in addition to the Single Supplement fee.

Cancellations and Refunds: Cancellations must be received in writing in order for any refunds to be issued, and will be processed according to the date the written notice is received. Although a verbal cancellation is also appreciated, it will not be accepted as official notice. Please mail the cancellation notice to the address below. In the event of cancellation, monies will be refunded minus the cancellation fee. The cancellation fee will be calculated as follows:

- 60 days prior to departure: \$500.00 per participant deposit
- 59 to 30 days prior to departure: \$500 per participant deposit and 50% of total cost*
- 29 days or less prior to departure: 100% of total cost*

* Cost includes: Land Package and single supplement, if applicable.

If you purchase travel insurance, it may cover the amount remaining after refund, depending on the circumstances of the cancellation and the conditions of the policy. Check with your travel insurance provider, if applicable.

Tour Cancellation by ITVP: On rare occasions a pilgrimage may have to be canceled due to lack of participation.

In such a case, ITVP's sole responsibility is to provide a full refund. ITVP is not responsible and does not assume responsibility for any additional costs or any fees relating to the issuance and/or cancellation of air tickets or other arrangements not made through ITVP.

Cancellations due to state advisories and/or state warnings, acts of war, terrorism, acts of God, natural disaster or any other circumstance outside the control of ITVP, are not the fault of ITVP. Great effort will be made to accommodate transfers to another trip or to revise the itinerary; however, cancellation for any of these reasons will not be eligible for a refund.
